- 8. Scholarship funds will only be awarded (ONCE) to the student's college/university OR trade school account upon your application being reviewed by the committee and selected as a scholarship recipient.

Criteria

- 1. Applicant must be a resident of Hamilton County.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or GED equivalent.
- 3. Applicant must be enrolled in the Guiding Light Mentoring Program two (2) years prior to the submission date of application.
- 4. Applicant GPA must be 2.0 or higher.
- 5. Applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student at a college /university carrying at least 12 credit hours or must be enrolled full-time at a trade school.
- 6. Applicant must have an acceptance letter from a college/university and/or trade school.

Application Process

- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee with a brief explanation of career goals.
